The two-phase master plan for this growing congregation is centered around a "Great Lawn" and signature tower. The two-story, 22,000 square foot Phase I building includes a 350 seat sanctuary, chapel, and administrative offices on the upper level with classrooms and an interim fellowship hall on the lower level. Phase II will include the permanent fellowship hall, kitchen, additional classrooms, and administrative offices.

The Phase I sanctuary is designed with a traditional gable roof structure and side aisles, while a rotated secondary axis begins at the new tower and terminates at the chancel communion table. The interplay between the main building axis and the shifted secondary axis creates a dynamic architectural relationship between the simple building container and the church's sacred worship activities.
