High demand in the rapidly growing area of Prince William County required the Nokesville Volunteer Fire Department #25 station to be built on an accelerated timeline of design and construction.

The station exterior is constructed of durable, low-maintenance materials such as metal roofing, brick, pre-cast concrete, and metal clad windows. Other design features such as a skylit dining area, oversized dayroom with fireplace, and large outdoor patio with gas grill were incorporated to successfully recruit new members and families to staff the newly deployed apparatus.

The interiors also consist of durable, easy-to-maintain materials such as masonry partitions, porcelain tile floors, and metal framed windows. Bunk rooms accommodate a total of 24 staff; featuring both gender specific and "flex" bunks; separate bath and locker facilities are provided for men and women. Administrative offices for this multi-station department are on the second floor along with a sub-dividable 80 person training classroom and public restrooms.
